Toton Connect Plus 110

I am writing on behalf of over 50 households in the Toton, Attenborough and Stapleford area, all of whom have contacted me in order to express their concerns about Nottinghamshire County Council's proposals to reduce the Toton Connect Plus 110 service.

As I am sure you are aware, transport within this part of the county is particularly poor, and many individuals rely on this service to carry out essential tasks such as attending medical appointments, shopping and travelling to work.

I have received a large volume of correspondence from constituents that use this service, and it is clear that the Toton Connect provides a vital link for many within the area, particularly those who are elderly, have mobility difficulties, are unable to drive or do not have access to alternative transport arrangements. The Toton Connect therefore allows the most dependent people within the area, to maintain their independence, and I am concerned that the County Council is considering reducing this service.

Given the support for the Toton Connect within the local community and the lack of public transport in the area, I would be grateful for your assurances that this excellent service will not be reduced.
