**Speeding in Moorgreen on the B6010 and B600**

Yet again I have had concerns raised with me about speeding in Moorgreen which has been a regular problem for my constituents for what has been far too long.

The roads with particular problems are Moorgreen, which travels from the Horse & Groom Pub to Nottingham Road in Newthorpe (the B6010) and Church Road, which travels into Moorgreen from Greasley, round a bend and out of the town away from the same pub (the B600).

This issue is also the subject of a long-running campaign by Moorgreen Residents' Association and I am forwarding a copy of this letter to the association's Secretary, Rita Pickering.

Moorgreen Residents' Association have run a Community Speed Watch Scheme in the past and have been successful in getting the speed limit on the B6000 reduced; at first to 40mph and then to 30mph. However, the reduction in the speed limit has done little to prevent speeding which still remains a real concern for local residents and their councillors.

My team have asked VIA for information relating to accidents on both roads and I am told that there have been 5 accidents resulting in injury on the B600 from January 2013 to October 2016. Furthermore there have been 4 accidents on the B6010 between Nottingham Road and the Horse and Jockey Pub in the same time period, including one which resulted in serious injury.


We have also been informed that there were a number of accidents between the Horse & Groom Pub and Engine Lane just before Christmas.

The extent and length of time that speeding on these roads has been a problem is unacceptable and I have raised this issue with Nottinghamshire County Council on the behalf of Moorgreen Residents' Association on a number of occasions previously. I would ask that a solution is found as soon as possible, either through the introduction of permanent speed cameras or other traffic enforcement measures.

I am copying in Inspector Steve Wragg for his information, County Councillor John Handley who I know has shared residents' concerns for many years and Greasley's Borough Councillors Margaret Handley, Mick Brown and Eddie Cubley.

As ever, I would be grateful for your assistance with this ongoing matter.
