Hello again,

This is just a quick reminder that I am holding a "Drop in" surgery at Madhatters Tea Room in Kimberley tomorrow from 10am. Scroll on down for details of some other events in the constituency this weekend.

I am pleased to announce that as a result of my meetings with the City Council they have agreed to an "exceptional hardship" fund for shops and businesses on High Road and Chilwell Road suffering from the complete closure of the road, due to the tramworks. A sum of £50,000 has been put forward (I am not convinced it is enough) which they suggest should be administered by the Beeston BID. The City is also prepared to raise the cap on claims from £13,000 to £20,000. Nottinghamshire County Council have been very helpful and I anticipate they will back the City's proposals.

However, these arrangements will not improve the situation for the car dealership, Pentagon, as they are outside the existing scheme. I remain very concerned that without support they will leave Chilwell Road with the loss of 20 jobs.

Finally, along with other groups (like Stapleford's STRAG) fighting to save our Green Belt, I have made my final written submissions to the Inspector conducting the forthcoming Public Inquiry into future development in Broxtowe.
