Hello again,

It has been an honour, a privilege and hugely enjoyable to be your MP for the last five years. I very much hope you will re-elect me so I can continue my work for everyone in Broxtowe.

On the doorstep, in our great town centres and by email and letter I have received support and kind words from all quarters. Labour, Lib Dem and independent voters have told me they will be voting for me tomorrow.
