Hello again,

As you may have heard Boots have announced 400 job losses at their Beeston headquarters. I will be holding a meeting with executives following this very disappointing and concerning news. The jobs are to go over the next three years and come despite the upturn in the economy and falling unemployment in Broxtowe.

Boots have already said that they will be minimising redundancies by redeploying or retraining staff where possible; I want details of their plans and I want the assurance that all efforts will be made to retrain and help workers into other jobs. I also want a commitment from Boots to Beeston and their assurance that there will be no further job losses.

Thugs ruin Hemlock Happening - full enquiry promised

There have been widespread reports about events on Saturday evening at the Hemlock Happening. A number of youths were arrested for fighting and the event was closed early meaning the firework display was cancelled. I have spoken to Stapleford Councillors Richard MacRae and Adam Stockwell who were present when groups of teenagers, apparently fuelled by alcohol, started fighting. Broxtowe Borough Council organise the event and Council Leader Richard Jackson is meeting the police for a full debrief on Wednesday; Richard has then promised a full meeting with all interested parties. I support Stapleford and Bramcote Councillors who are keen for lessons to be learnt so this popular family event can continue without incident for years to come.

Trip to Parliament

I have organised a trip to Parliament on Monday June 29. The cost of the coach to Westminster is £14.50 - the excellent tour of both the House of Commons and Parliament is free. It's an early start from the constituency office (5.30am returning for 6pm) but everyone who has been in previous years says it's been a wonderful experience.
